Medical Alert Card

I have had polio. Some drugs may worsen the symptoms of the Late Effects of Polio and should be avoided or used with caution

Polio Australia issues the following International Medical Alert for polio survivors.

NOTE: These drugs may worsen post polio symptoms and should be avoided or if absolutely necessary - should be used with caution

- cholesterol reducing drugs eg statins, lipitor, zocor etc
- beta-blockers eg betaloc, inderal, tenormin, atenolol
- benzodiazapines eg valium, serapax, ativan
- CNS depressants eg mogadon, normison, tramal
- muscle relaxants eg scoline atropine, buscopan
- local anaesthetic incl eye drops eg ligno & xylocaine
- general anaesthetics all types monitor patient with greater care. Avoid pre-med & muscle relaxants.
